- The Child Passenger Safety team educates the public on topics dealing with child safety in vehicles, including safety seats, safety belts and hot car deaths
- Check to Protect® program helps consumers and businesses find open recalls on vehicles

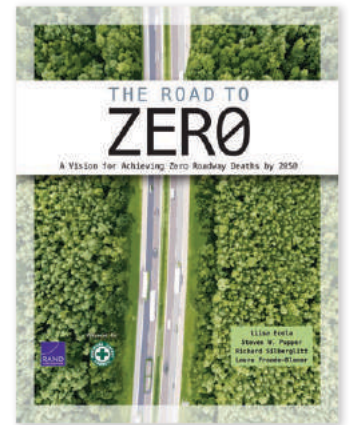
